


Constitution for the AAYU club

1. The name and logo

- i) The name of the club is AAYU which signifies the age of the human being.
- ii) The logo of the club is . The logo consists of the letters 'AAYU' in a stylized blue font, where the 'Y' is replaced by the Devanagari character 'यु'.

2. Manifesto of the club

- i) To work for the human society.
- ii) To promote the traditional way to achieve health and age with modern ideas.
- iii) To promote the correct methodology to achieve health using the upgraded scientific awareness.

3. Functions of the club

- i) The aayu club will generate a forum of humans having similar thoughts as that of manifesto of the club.
- ii) The aayu club will provide a platform to its members for scientific discussions.
- iii) The aayu club will organise various activities to increase the awareness of the public.
- iv) The aayu club will organize various events to extract the matured and immature scientific ideas.
- v) The aayu club will support by participation and sponsoring events which has same motive as that of the club.
- vi) The aayu club will support the direct and indirect growth of traditional medicines by manufacturing and marketing with advanced utilities.

4. Structure of the club

- i) The club will be having a chief patron Mr. Ashok Mittal, life time.
- ii) The club will be having a patron Dr. Monica Gulati, life time.
- iii) The club will be having the constitutional body as a life time member.
- iv) The club will be having the functioning body constituting one president, one vice-president, one general secretary, one organising secretary, six executive members.
- v) The club will be having other active bodies as organised by the functioning body from time to time.

5. Constitutional body

5.1. Functions of the constitutional body

- i) The constitutional body will generate the constitution of the club.
- ii) The body will timely evaluate the functioning of the club and will propose any modification of the constitution. At least five members (three from executive members and two from governing body) are required for the proposal for the modification.
- iii) The body will be having the rights to change the constitution of the club with approval of the functioning body.
- iv) The body will govern and countersign the any proposed change in the constitution by the functioning body. At least five members (three from executive members and two from governing body) are required for the final the proposed modification.

5.2. Structure of the body

- i) The first functioning body will be the constitutional body of the club.
- ii) Any modification or volunteer declining is possible with the approval of the five members (three from executive members and two from governing body) and governing body of the functioning body, with approval from patron and chief patron.
- iii) New member can be added when clause two is applicable with the approval of five members (three from executive members and two from governing body) and governing body of the functioning body, with approval from patron and chief patron.

6. Functioning body

6.1. Structure of the Functioning body

- i) The body will constitute one president, one vice-president, one general secretary, one organising secretary, six executive members.
- ii) There will be a governing body of president, vice-president, general secretary, and organising secretary.

6.2. Function of the governing body

- i) The body will govern over the functioning of functioning body and other bodies, committees and sub-organisations.

6.3. Functions of the functioning body

- i) The functioning body will execute all the functions of the club.

- ii) The functioning body will govern the policies for new members.
- iii) The functioning body will reconstitute the constitution of the club.
