**No. LPU/Notification/007/2006** - In pursuance of the provisions of sub-clause (12.2.1) of clause 12.2.0 of The Statutes made under sub-section (1) of section 24 of The Lovely Professional University Act, 2005 (Punjab Act No. 25 of 2005), the following Migration Rules of the Lovely Professional University received the approval of the Academic Council on the 10th June, 2006 and thereafter the assent of the Chancellor on the 23rd June, 2006, and are hereby published for general information:-

## MIGRATION RULES

OF

LOVELY PROFESSIONAL UNIVERSITY

(Under Clause 12.2.0 (12.2.1) of The Statutes of the Lovely Professional University)

### 1.0 Short Title, Extent and Commencement

- 1.1 These rules will be called "Migration Rules of Lovely Professional University".
- 1.2 If there is difference in Ordinance of Migration and rules of migration, Ordinance will prevail.
- 1.3 He / She, is same and used interchangeably.
- 1.4 These Rules shall come into force at once.

**2.0** The term migration is used whenever student wants to change the University / College / Board / Institution before the completion of programme and is used in context of the following:

**2.1 Migration to the University (Also known as Admission with Advanced Standing)**

Migration from any other University/College/Board/Council/Institution (in and outside the State and/Country) to the Lovely Professional University (here in after called as the University) and/or its Schools/Institutes or affiliated institutions.

**2.2 Migration from the University**

Migration from the University and/or its Schools/Institutes or affiliated institutions to any other University/College/Board/Council/Institution.

**3.0 Eligibility Conditions for Migration to the University**

Students from other University/College/Board/Council/Institution may migrate to the University and/or its School/Institutes or affiliated Institutions during the Programme , subject to the following conditions:

3.1 The migration is allowed only in case candidate is presently studying in University/College/Board/Council/Institution recognized by the concerned regulatory / apex body.

3.2 The migration of a candidate from other University/College/Board/Council/Institution shall not be permitted unless the qualifying examination passed by the candidate has been recognized as equivalent to the corresponding examination of the University and he fulfills the minimum qualification and other requirements laid down for admission to the class or the Programme to which he seeks migration in the University.

Explanation: The Equivalence Committee may be appointed by the University, to verify the equivalence of a degree / diploma / certificate.

3.3 The applicant satisfies the eligibility criteria as was prescribed for the program for the concerned batch (in which migration is sought).

Explanation: If a candidate is seeking advanced standing in 3<sup>rd</sup> term of B.Tech in the year 2008 then the applicant shall satisfy the eligibility criteria as was prescribed for this batch of B.Tech CSE at the time of admission i.e. in year 2007

3.4 The academic contents of the Programme in respect of the syllabus of previous years should not be materially different. The similarity / equivalence of the syllabus will be decided by the Equivalence Committee appointed by the University. The committee may disapprove the migration or approve the migration with or without conditions as deemed fit.

Explanation:

(a) Migrating student may be awarded one or more backlog courses (subjects) and asked to register and pass these backlog courses (subjects) depending on the difference in the course (subjects) covered by such candidate in the previous university / institute.

(b) Equivalence committee may also give waiver of few courses (subjects) depending on the courses (subjects) that applicant have studied in previous University / Institute / College and will be taught in the coming term(s) in the programme in the University in which migration is sought.

3.5 Migration in a Programme shall be allowed subject to the availability of the seats in the same Programme of study.

3.6 If migration is sought in a Programme being offered in regular mode of education, the migrating student must be from regular mode of education.

**3.7 Procedure of Migration to the University**

3.7.1 Migration shall be affected before the closing date fixed by the University for term registration of the concerned Programme, during a particular academic year. However in special cases, the University may sanction the migration during the term on valid reasons.

3.7.2 The applicant will apply for the migration to the Admission department of the University. Application for migration must be accompanied by the following, as and if desired:

- (a) Processing fee as prescribed by the University (non-refundable).
- (b) 'No Objection Certificate' from Head/Director/Principal of the other University/College/Board/Council/Institution where student is currently studying.
- (c) The migration certificate in original from the University from which he is migrating, as and when required.
- (d) Certificate of good moral character in original from the Head of the Institution from which the migration is sought.
- (e) Certificates of result of examination and the tests passed with detailed results.
- (f) Syllabus of the Courses (subjects) studied till date in the Current program.
- (g) Any other certificate or document as desired by the University.

3.7.3 In case applicants seeking migration are more than the seats available, migration will be allowed on the basis of merit or as decided by the University.

3.7.4 Migration cannot be claimed as a matter of right and may be refused by the University without assigning any reason.

3.7.5 All the rules, code, ordinances of the University including condition of 'Promotion to Next year' will be applicable to the migrated student.

3.7.6 No relaxation in academic and examination rules of this University shall be permitted to such migrating students.

3.7.7 If any regulatory body of a Programme, imposes certain conditions on the migration, the same shall be applicable.

**3.8 Applicable Fees in case of Migration to the University**

**3.8.1 Processing Fee for Migration to the University**

At the time of application for migration to the University, the applicant is required to pay the processing fee for migration as prescribed by the University and these charges will be non-refundable and non-adjustable irrespective of whether the migration is allowed by the competent authority or not or the student withdraws his application for migration.

**3.8.2 Fee for the current academic session and other dues**

The applicant shall on migration, be required to pay all the fees due for the current academic sessions as also the annual dues as applicable.

Explanation: In case, a student has migrated in the mid of a term, the full fees of the current term will be charged.

**3.8.3 Fee for Backlog Courses**

In addition to the above, in case the equivalence committee has approved the migration with condition of passing one or more courses, the student is liable to pay the fee for registration of these backlog courses as prescribed by the University.

**4.0 Migration from the University**

4.1 The application for Migration from the University and/or its Schools//Institutes to any other University/Institution may be considered only if:

The candidate has a valid reason such as compassionate ground - medical ground, security reasons and likewise for migration.

4.2 Migration cannot be claimed as a matter of right and may be refused by the University without assigning any reason.

4.3 Migration (if permitted) may be considered only after getting the No Dues Certificate with regard to submission of the total fee and all other dues payable by the student to the University, as if he had continued the stay in the University or its institutions for the complete duration of the Programme .

Explanation: In case student is studying in 6th term of B.Tech and is seeking migration from the University, then student is liable to pay all the dues of 7th and 8th term also as the corresponding seat cannot be filled at this juncture.

4.4 Once the migration of the student from the University has been permitted, University will be under no obligation to admit the student again in the University.

**5.0 Addition, Amendment, Repeal and Deletion of the Rules**

- 5.1 The Rules framed herein and the subsequent Rules may be added to, amended, repealed or deleted and every new Rules or addition to the Rules or any amendment or repeal of a Rules shall require the approval of the Chancellor, who may sanction, disallow or remit it for further consideration and it shall be effective from such a date as prescribed in the notification.
- 5.2 Notwithstanding such amendment, addition to or any repeal of any Rules, any thing done or any action taken under the said Rules shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of the Rules.

**6.0 Interpretation**

- 6.1 Any question relating to the clerical error, clarification, spelling mistake, interpretation or likewise related to any provision of Rules framed herein and the subsequent Rules of the University shall be decided by the Chancellor.
- 6.2 Notwithstanding anything stated in the Rules framed herein and the subsequent Rules, for any unforeseen issues arising that is not covered by the Rules, or in the event of dispute/differences of opinion in interpretation of any provision of the Rules and in respect of all the matters, whether expressly provided herein or not, the Chancellor may take such measures as may be necessary for removal of difficulties. The decision of the Chancellor shall be final and binding on all the concerned.
- 6.3. The Chancellor may, by general or special order, authorize such officer or authority to exercise any of the powers, exercisable by him, under these Rules or otherwise, as may be specified in the order. And, the decision of the Chancellor shall be final and binding on all the concerned.
