
At the outset Chairperson IQAC welcomed all the members of the IQAC committee and thereafter, the agenda was taken up.

1	Confirmation of the minutes of the 9 th meeting of IQAC held on 15 th October 2015.	Minutes of the meeting of IQAC held on 15 th October 2015 were unanimously confirmed after a careful consideration.
2	Action Taken Report (ATR) of the last 9 th meeting of the IQAC held on 15 th October 2015.	The members were apprised on ATR of the last meeting along with the progress of the decision taken in the last meeting with a note of satisfaction.
3	Review of Autumn Term (2015-16)	Meeting was apprised about the Autumn Term ended in December 2015. Discussion was made regarding library resources, evaluation and research promotions. Following measures were suggested by IQAC members: 3.1 Examination Reforms: IQAC members laid stress on bringing more transparency in the examination evaluation system. It was recommended that scrutiny of OMR sheets should also be started just like scrutiny of subjective examination to bring more transparency in examination evaluation system. 3.2 Automation of Result analysis: Discussion was made to reduce the time of declaration of result for various tests conducted by teachers and online analysis of the same through technology input. A platform should be developed to carry out result functions more efficiently and effectively as suggested by IQAC. 3.3 Online interview for Ph.D. aspirants: PhD

It was suggested that the PhD interview process should be made online and the PhD interviews could also be conducted through skype and other similar platforms.</p> <p>3.4 Online interface for Evaluation of State-of-the-Art Seminar: Discussion was made to bring reforms in the State-of-the-Art Seminar evaluation to efficiently complete the evaluation process. It was suggested that the evaluation of SOTA should be done online by the panelists by providing them evaluation Performa in UMS.</p>
4	Training in Hospitals for the students of Allied Medical Sciences	It was proposed by Director IQAC that external exposure to the students of Physiotherapy and Paramedical Sciences should be given in order to impart better skills and hands on training to them. IQAC members appreciated the proposal and resolved that the students of Physiotherapy and Paramedical sciences should be given training at various hospitals.
5	Overview of status of research conferences	An overview of the conferences being organized in LPU was presented by Head, Division of Research and Development. It was debated that measures can be taken to further increase the quality outputs. Therefore, screening of research papers should be done rigorously and efforts should be done to publish selected papers in indexed journals.
6	Innovation in Teaching learning methods	It was felt that learning of students can be enhanced by adopting innovative and relevant teaching learning methods. Moot court practice as a teaching learning method was specifically discussed by the IQAC members in this regard for law students. It was suggested that a National Moot Court Competition should be organized to provide a platform to law students where they could self-evaluate themselves and learn new things by competing and exchanging ideas with other national level moot court teams.
