## Minutes of the 16<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC),



At the outset Chairperson IQAC welcomed all the members of the IQAC committee and thereafter, the agenda was taken up.

1	Confirmation of the minutes of the 15 <sup>th</sup> meeting of IQAC held on 25 <sup>th</sup> April 2017.	Minutes of the meeting of IQAC held on 25 <sup>th</sup> April 2017 were unanimously confirmed after a careful consideration
2	Action Taken Report (ATR) of the 15 <sup>th</sup> meeting of the IQAC held on 25 <sup>th</sup> April 2017.	The members were apprised on ATR of the last meeting and the members were satisfied with the progress.
3	Review of Academic Session 2016-17	<p>A presentation was given by Director, IQAC on the review of Academic Session 2016-17. Based on the presentation, analysis and discussions, the members suggested following points</p> <p><b>3.1 Outcome based Education:</b> IQAC proposed that Outcome Based Education System should be further improved by mapping Course Outcomes with Bloom words. IQAC decided that questions should be mapped with learning outcomes.</p> <p><b>3.2 Automation of Continuous Assessment:</b> While discussion member made a point that as all Continuous Assessment (CA) is available online therefore automation of Continuous Assessment (CA) attainment report should be generated through an interface to save the time of staff/faculty members. IQAC made resolution to design an interface for the same.</p> <p><b>3.3 Facilities of physically challenged students:</b> Members enquired about the present status of the facilities available of physically challenged student specifically for examination purposes. It was informed that writers are provided for physically challenged students in writing examination. IQAC informed that a formal policy shall be drafted to provide writer for</p>

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		<p>the physically challenged and seriously injured students.</p> <p><b>3.4 Incubation facilities for students:</b> Discussion was made on providing more incubation facilities to students for adequate running of their business. IQAC suggested that adequate space should be provided to the students for Incubation of projects so as to launch their businesses by Division of Startup.</p> <p><b>3.5 Training Need Identification for Faculty &amp; Staff:</b> Discussion was made to customize the training options to faculty or staff by HRDC as per department needs. IQAC proposed that scope of Faculty Development should be widened by covering a large variety of topics suggested by the faculty through Training Need Identification exercise.</p>
4	Participation in NIRF Rankings	The university desires to participate in NIRF rankings for the year 2018. Members discussed the potential ranking strengths of various schools and resolved that LPU should participate in Management, Pharmacy and Architecture disciplines of NIRF ranking.
5	Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA)	AAA report was presented in the meeting and it was highly appreciated as University has received Four Star rating in the Audit conducted by Indian Centre for Academic Rankings and Excellence (ICARE). Suggestion has been made by the committee that initiatives should be taken according to the observation/feedback provided in the report of Academic and Administrative Audit.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by the Chairperson.
