### Minutes of the 18<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC),



3	To Review Autumn term (2017-18)	<p>A presentation was made by director IQAC on Universities activities conducted during autumn term December 2017.</p> <p><b>3.1 To strengthen Outcome Based Education system:</b> Opinion was given to strengthen the course outcome-based evaluation systems through mapping of the courses. IQAC members informed that the task of strengthening the outcome-based evaluation system should be assigned to Division of Academic Affairs through mapping the course outcome with Academic task. A report to be submitted in next meeting.</p> <p><b>3.2 Analysis of Programme Outcome Attainment:</b> The members asked to analyze the attainment of programme outcomes through online report.</p> <p><b>3.3 Evaluation process and Reforms:</b> The members discussed about the existing evaluation system and suggested that online system should be developed for the evaluation of various exams/trainings like Mid-term, End term, Continuous assessment, FDP's etc.</p>

		<p><b>3.4 Intensification of ICT in teaching learning process:</b> The Vice Chancellor emphasized that the use of ICT in teaching learning process shall be intensified to achieve better objectives and outcomes of the courses. It was also felt that faculty should be provided ICT based training to get acquainted with the effective use of technology for effective imparting of knowledge and skills among students.</p> <p><b>3.5 To Explore the maximum Placement of Students:</b> Based on the placement data presented, the members showed their concerns and asked that Head, Career Services/HOSs shall make efforts to place every student through company placement/entrepreneurship/higher studies.</p>
4	To prepare and present the Self-Study Report for ICAR Accreditation	Dean, School of Agriculture informed that Letter of Intent (LoI) was accepted by ICAR. The members congratulated the Dean and asked that SSR should be compiled as envisaged by ICAR guidelines. Reports for individual programmes should be prepared and presented before the IQAC separately along with the report of the school in next IQAC meeting.
5	To increase research scholars by reviewing Teaching fellowship policy	Dr. Harminder Singh mentioned that recently government of India has enhanced the fellowship amount for research scholars therefore to attract quality research scholars the teaching fellowship policy may be reviewed. The members immediately accepted the suggestion and asked to review the policy.
