
At the outset Chairperson IQAC welcomed all the members of the IQAC committee and thereafter, the agenda was taken up.

2	To report action taken on minutes of the meeting of IQAC held on 20 <sup>th</sup> July 2018.	The action Taken Report of the minutes of the meeting of IQAC held on 20 <sup>th</sup> July 2018 were placed and approved by the IQAC.
3	Quarterly progress report presentation on activities conducted by IQAC	<p>A progress report of the initiatives taken up by IQAC was presented by the Director IQAC (List appended) which was appreciated by the members and following suggestions were given:</p> <p><b>3.1 To Form dynamic mechanism for obtaining student feedback for labs and workshops:</b> The IQAC members resolved that a dynamic system for student feedback after every lab and workshop should be developed for efficient lab operations.</p> <p><b>3.2 To reframe induction programme for faculty members:</b> Director IQAC informed that LPU is organizing induction/orientation programme for newly joined faculty members. However, there is a scope to include more modules regarding policies and process of the University. Therefore, induction framework should be revised.</p>
4	Feedback Analysis of Stakeholder for the session 2017-18	Feedback received from students, teachers, parents, employers, and alumni on curriculum, teaching-learning, pedagogy, and support systems have been analyzed. In general, the feedback received on various parameters was found satisfactory. The members appreciated the feedback system and suggested to take the necessary

		action and submit the Action Taken Report to the Academic Council.
5	Annual Reports	Annual reports of Division of Examination, Human Resource Development Center, Division of Career Services, E-Governance, IQAC and University were presented in the meeting. Members were satisfied with the reports and recommended the same to be presented in the relevant Council of the university for approval.
6	To compile and submit information NIRF Rankings	Director, IQAC presented a report about the information/data collected for NIRF rankings 2019. The members suggested that LPU data should be benchmarked with the last year data of few highly ranked institutions and agreed that application should be submitted before the due date.
7	To apply for ARIIA Rankings	IQAC members discussed and resolved that University should apply for ARIIA Innovation Rankings to MHRD.
8	Report on Status of ICAR Accreditation of School of Agriculture	It was informed to IQAC members that SSR for accreditation of School of Agriculture has been accepted by ICAR and subsequently ICAR peer team visited the School on 24 <sup>th</sup> and 25 <sup>th</sup> September 2018. The peer team members were highly satisfied with the infrastructure and teaching facilities. The result is awaited.
9	To promote students Projects for Indian Science Congress	IQAC Director informed the members that LPU is organizing 106 <sup>th</sup> Indian Science Congress from 3 <sup>rd</sup> to 7 <sup>th</sup> January 2019. It is planned that LPU students should take maximum benefit of the event by interacting with the national and international experts and display their projects based on innovative ideas. The members appreciated the idea and suggested maximum number of students should participate.
10	To Promote entrepreneurship to increase start-ups by Students	As Government of India has initiated a number of incentives for the young entrepreneurs under start up India scheme to motivate more students, therefore, the University plans to introduce entrepreneurship development programme for the students under Division of Start-up. Members appreciated the plan and suggested that expert workshops/lectures should also be organized to motivate and guide the students.
11	Report of Swachhata Ranking 2018	Director IQAC, happily informed the house that Lovely Professional University has been ranked at 8 <sup>th</sup> position at national level under University (Residential category) in
