Minutes of the 23rd meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)



1	To Confirm the minutes of the meeting of IQAC held on 10 th January 2019.	The minutes of the meeting of the IQAC held on 10 th January 2019 were placed and approved by IQAC.
2	To report action taken on minutes of the meeting of IQAC held on 10 th January 2019.	The Action Taken Report of the minutes of the meeting of the IQAC held on 10 th January 2019 were presented and approved by IQAC.
3	IQAC presentation of activities	Director IQAC made a presentation of the initiatives taken up by the IQAC in the last three months. IQAC members appreciated the initiatives taken. (List of Activities appended). IQAC suggested that for promoting entrepreneurship, relevant seminars/workshops etc. should be conducted.
4	To Review the progress of NAAC SSR Compilation	IQAC members discussed about the progress of work done for the that NAAC SSR. It was suggested that a committee should be constituted for regular review of data compilation and document verification. Names of Dr. Rajeev Sobti, Dr. Manish Gupta, Dr. Rajesh Verma, Mr. Navdeep Dhaliwal, Dr. Sorabh Lakhanpal and Ms. Soosan Chhabra were recommended by the IQAC Members for this task.
5	To report NIRF Rankings result	Members were apprised that the University secured 52 nd Rank in Management, 27 th Rank in Pharmacy, 125 th Rank in Engineering, and 101-150 Rank band overall in NIRF 2019. IQAC members appreciated the achievement of the University.
6	To design dynamic system for library user feedback	Director IQAC informed the IQAC members that the dynamic system of recording student

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		feedback after each lab class i.e. Lab Resource Reporting Engine has been successfully implemented. He also proposed that a similar interface should be designed for other aspects of teaching learning and resources. IQAC members welcomed the proposal and resolved that interfaces to record real time feedback in classroom teaching as well as for and academic library should be Designed.
7	To review the plan for Curriculum Development and Review for session 2019-20	Head Division of Academic Affairs presented the plan for curriculum Development and Review (CDR) for the session 2019-20. It was emphasized that faculty members involved in CDR should be educated about the latest developments in the field. It was recommended by IQAC that an Orientation/Training session for Curriculum Development should be conducted.
8	Bifurcation of School of Computer Science and Engineering	In last few years, a lot of advancements has been witnessed in the field of computing. In School of Computer Science and Engineering, LPU is having fairly a good volume and demand is also good. Thus, it is suggested that we should work on a new school and offers new programs as per the need of industry.
9	Bifurcation of Mittal School of Business	In order to enable greater innovation in curriculum design and delivery and build greater challenge for students of management and allied programmes, both at PG and UG level, it was suggested that the Mittal School of Business be split into two schools
