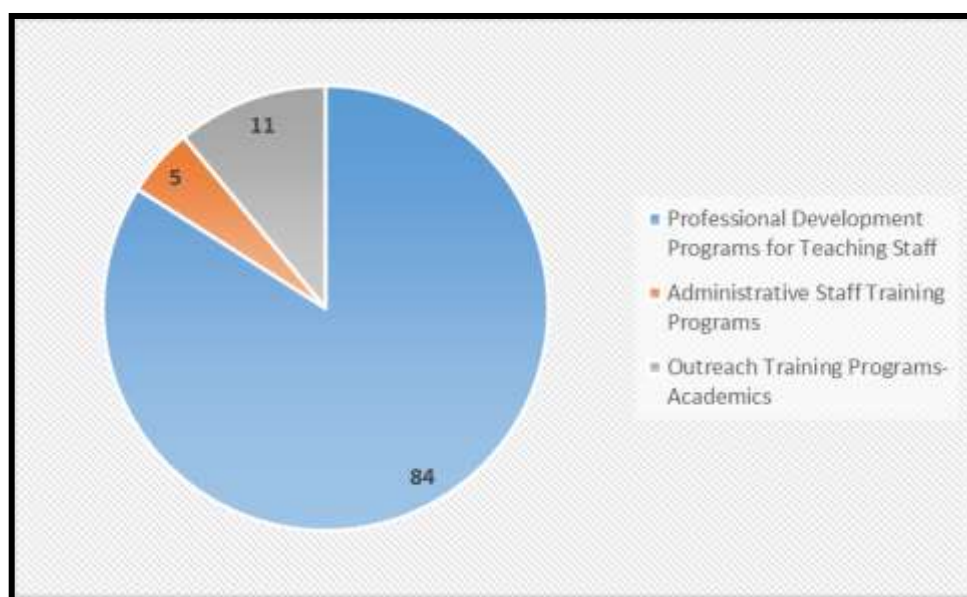


Fig. 1: Classification of Training Program (2017-18)
