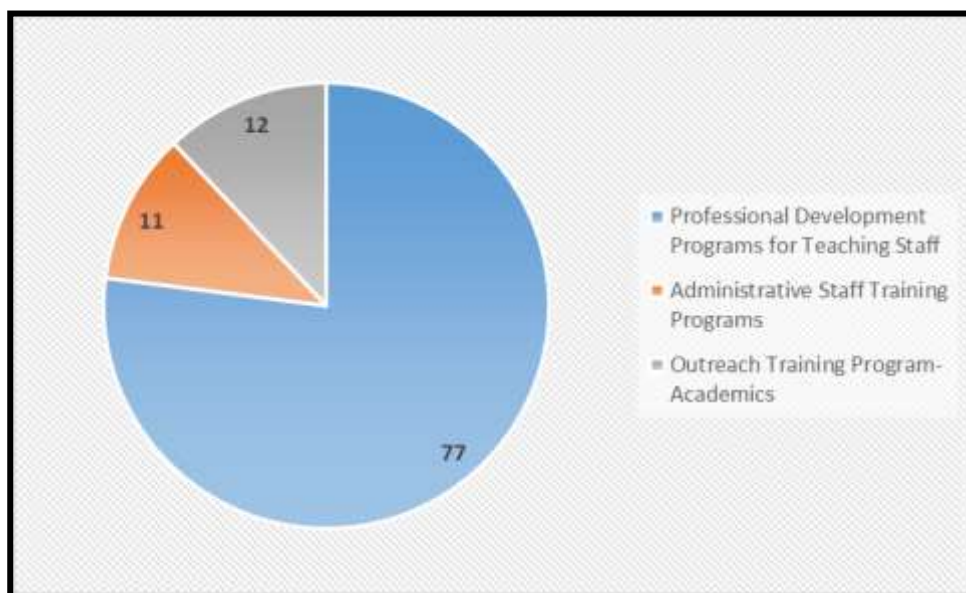


Fig. 1: Classification of Training Programs (2018-19)


5. RANKINGS & ACHIEVEMENTS


