This application which is supported on all leading digital platforms allows the faculty to share learning support material in the form of e-content like lecture notes, reading material, audio-video (AV) aids etc. This application can also be used by the faculty to share important and specific academic announcements with their students.</p> <p>3.Course Enrichment: In order to broaden the students' educational experiences, opportunities were provided to students to interact with the most reputed academicians, industry experts and professionals in their respective fields.
