An MoU was signed between LPU and High Commission of Bangladesh in India to enhance the friendship further with Bangladesh

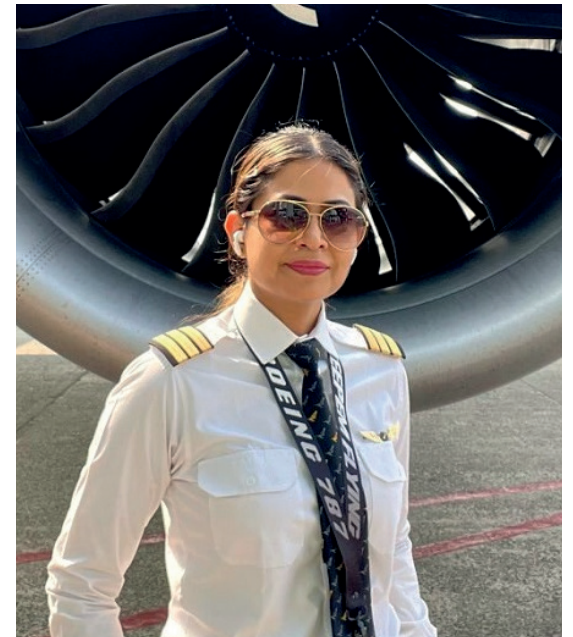
Bangladesh in India to further seek the possibility of the established Corner eventually being converted into a Centre at LPU. It also covered student and faculty exchange and research programmes.

Interaction with Air India Captain Shivani Kalra



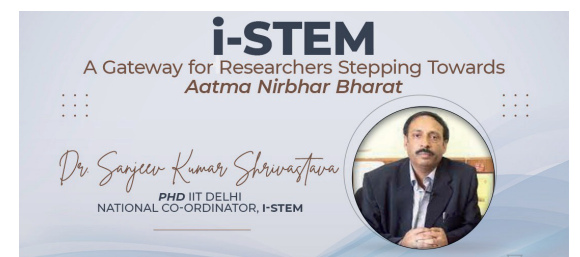

Interestingly, "The Kashmir Files" has emerged as the first choice of moviegoers despite big-budget films including "Radhe Shyam", "Batman"

and "Gangubai Kathiawadi" releasing in the same time.

Unlike these films, "The Kashmir Files" also doesn't boast of any big mainstream commercial star. While South superstar Prabhas is in the lead role in "Radhe Shyam", "Batman" has Hollywood's Robert Pattinson.

"Gangubai Kathiawadi" is directed by acclaimed filmmaker Sanjay Leela Bhansali and stars Alia Bhatt.

"The Kashmir Files" is being hailed for its "honest" and "earnest" attempt to bring forth the plight of more than five lakh Kashmiri Pandits who had to leave behind everything they had in the Valley in 1990.

"The Kashmir Files" was the top trending hashtag on Twitter in India over the weekend with half a million tweets, flooded with emotional moments and netizens sharing their tragedy from the exodus days.

The film has also stoked controversy over allegations of reduced cinema halls allotted and so-called film critics dismissing the film as propaganda, despite all the brutalities depicted in the film being documented evidence. This film has mainly relied on word of mouth publicity. Since then, many people have come to offer free tickets to people for the movie at their preferred location and preferred time.

The crisis that can change Europe forever

The crisis is not about Ukraine but Russia. If Washington is serious about limiting Russian power, it should focus less on what comes after a Russian attack than on offering Ukraine the tools to defend itself, especially during the initial stages of conflict

European countries are already divided on many matters. There are fastgrowing concerns that this could greatly worsen unless Russia and the United States can come up with some diplomatic solution to the Ukraine crisis. That looks increasingly unlikely. Commodities are being priced near their highest premium on record to deliveries one year ahead, a measure known as "backwardation" that reflects how physical supplies of everything from oil to corn remain tight amid booming demand and rising geopolitical tensions.

Because of the war, Russia suffers from financial crisis Here are few more pointers.
1. Because of Russia and Ukraine crisis, the stock market will be going down
2. In Russia and Ukraine, the public faces the food and fuel

shortage because now there is not so much sources there.
3. The prices will effect all over the world on oil and gas because the world is dependent on Russia for both to a certain extent.

The crisis is not about Ukraine but Russia. If Washington is serious about limiting Russian power, it should focus less on what comes after a Russian attack than on offering Ukraine the tools to defend itself, especially during the initial stages of conflict, when air and standoff missile strikes will be deployed against military bases, power plants, key transportation nodes and other critical infrastructure.

Mesmerising views at Spring Flower Show & Competition

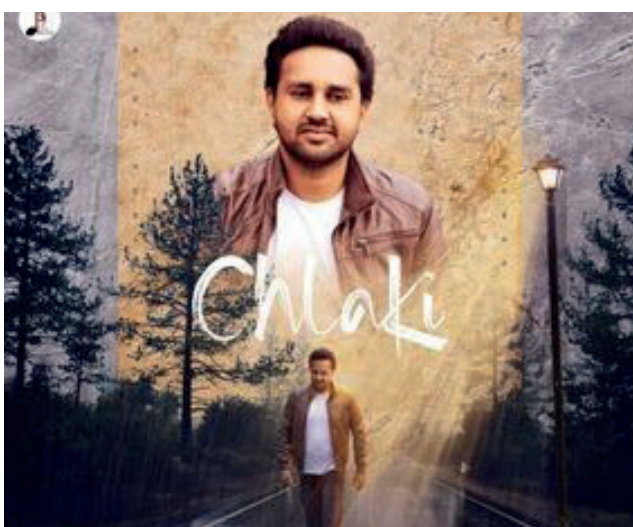
