The Division of Career Services and Centre of Professional Enhancement at LPU organized the event.

LPU has once again registered one of the highest numbers of placement offers as well as the highest package record in the country for the year 2022. An alumnus from the B Tech

class of 2018, Yasir M has been working at a record-breaking package of Rs 3 Crore in Germany. Perhaps, it is one of the highest packages received by any of the recent years' alumni of India.

Another alumnus from the B Tech

class of 2020, Harekrishna Mahto is placed with Google at a package of Rs 64 Lacs. One of the world's top AI (Artificial Intelligence) domain companies has recruited LPU B Tech. CSE 2022 batch student, Arjun, at INR 62.72 Lakh. This is one of the highest packages received by any fresher student. With this, LPU has broken its own record, as this package is nearly 1.5 times (50%) higher than the previous year's highest of INR 42 Lakh for a fresher.

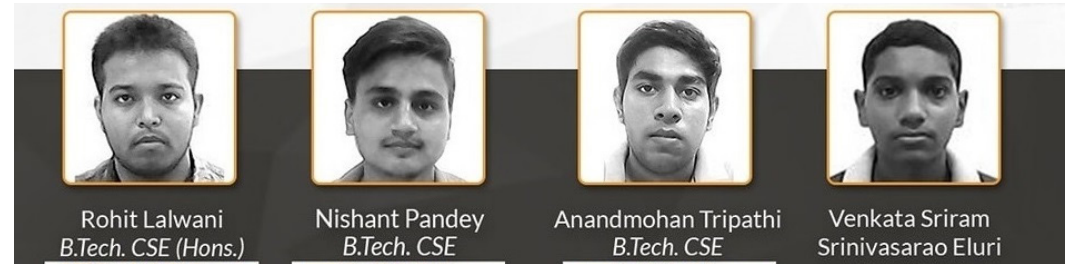

LPU students win 19 trophies at Punjab State Youth Festival 22



Hon'ble Chief Minister of Punjab Bhagwant Mann honoured LPU students with 2nd Runner-Up trophy for Punjab's inter-university youth festival. More than 3,000 students from 30 varsities across the state had participated in the competitive event. Winning a huge haul of 19 medals, including 3 Gold, 10 Silver & 6 Bronze; LPU students are awarded with the trophy for exhibiting versatile talent for 'Punjab & Punjabiyat'.

LPU Alumna received Prime Minister Research Fellowship



Paulomi Singh, a graduate of LPU's Bachelor of Technology in Nanotechnology programme, has been awarded the Prime Minister Research Fellowship!

She earned a Bachelor of Technology degree in nanotechnology and focused her major project on developing

a polymer nanocomposite that is capable of functioning as a hydrogen-based sensor. She passed GATE exam and was granted admission to study at one of India's most prestigious universities, the IIT (BHU) in Varanasi. Making an anti-bacterial mask was the focus of her project

work for her master's degree. In her master's program, she studied material characterization, composite materials, the synthesis of nanomaterials and polymers, and the mechanical behaviour of materials. Currently, she is working on the perovskite solar cell project.
