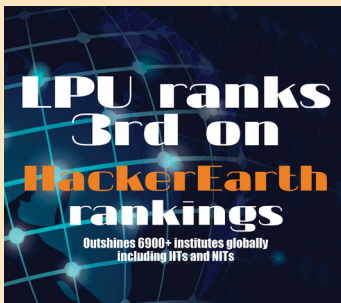

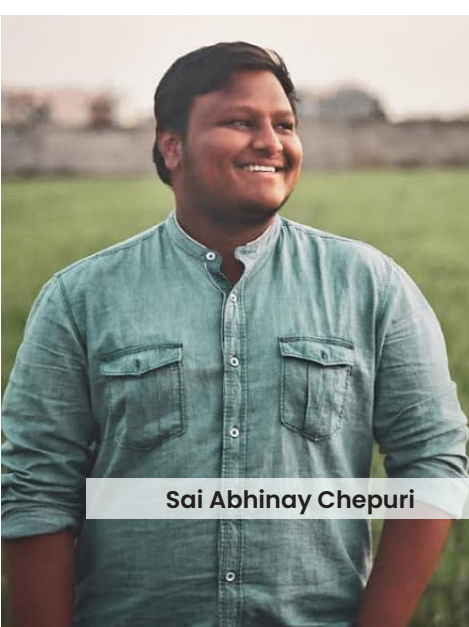

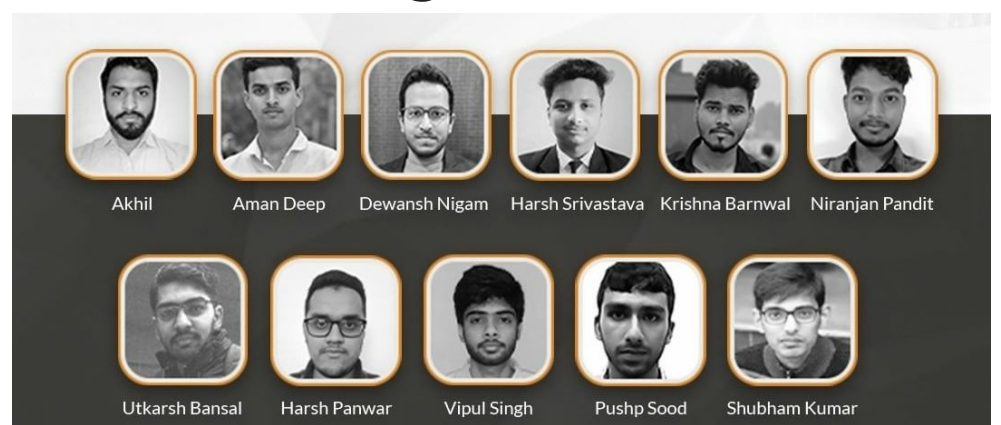

Commonwealth Games in Cardiff in 1958. He defeated Malcolm Spence of South Africa with a timing of 46.6 seconds. He has four Asian Games gold medals in his name – 200m and 400m in 1958, and 400m and 4x400m relay in 1962. While he participated in 1960 Rome Olympics too, but he finished fourth in the 400m race.

Who could have thought a Milkha would one day get the sobriquet of 'The Flying Sikh'? He earned it, and earned it for good.

Milkha Singh, a Padma Shri Awardee, former Indian track and field sprinter who inspired generations of Indians with his feats on an international stage died last month in Chandigarh because of Covid-19 complications. A man of courage, Milkha said in his last interaction with PTI before being hospitalised. "Don't worry, I am in good

spirits...I am surprised, How could I get this infection?...I hope to get over it soon."

Nicknamed the Flying Sikh, a title was bestowed to Milkha by former Pakistan Army General Ayub Khan after he defeated Abdul Khaliq in the Pakistani soil.

Born in Gobindpura – in present day Pakistan – Milkha was the first Indian track and field athlete to win gold in the then British Empire and

Sonal has been an outstanding performer all along. Earlier this year, she won gold medal with a throw of 14.69m at Indian Grand Prix-3.

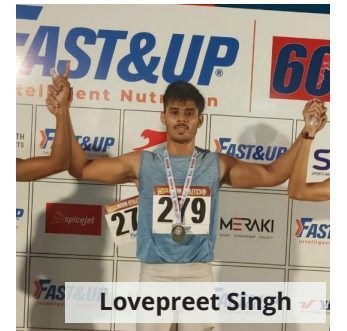

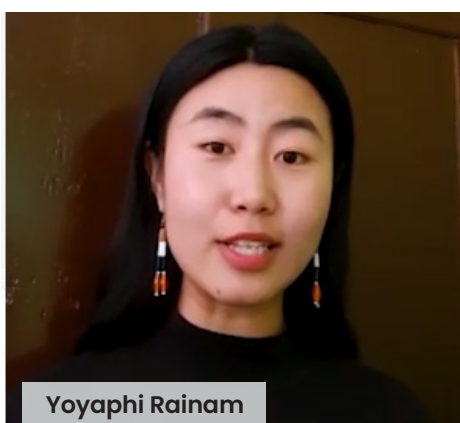

Verto and Javelin thrower Neeraj Chopra opened his international season with a promising 83.18m effort that fetched him a gold medal in the City of Lisbon athletics meet at the Lisbon University Stadium in Portugal last month.

The conditions were windy and Chopra - the Asian Games champion, who set a national record with an 88.07m throw in the Indian Grand Prix in Patiala in March - had a foul-ridden series messing up three of his six rounds. His best came in the last

round. He opened with an 80.71 and his other legal throw was 78.50 in the fourth.

Chopra has a season's best of 88.07m recorded in March in Patiala, Punjab. Lisbon competition marked Chopra's return to foreign soil after 18

months. In January 2020, he competed at the South African domestic meet in Potchefstroom. "I am now working on getting my release angle right and ensuring I get the proper height," he was quoted as saying by Sportstar.

Verto and athlete Amoj Jacob qualifies for 2021 Tokyo Olympics

A moment of pride and honour for LPU as its Verto and athlete Amoj Jacob, studying BPEd, has qualified for 2021 Tokyo Olympics. Amoj will represent India in 4X400m Relay men team. His 400m personal

"If you look at the personal bests of Muhammed Anas, Arokia Rajiv, Noah Nirmal Tom and me, all of us have gone below 46s," Jacob was quoted as saying by a national daily.

Nishad Kumar clinched gold medal in high jump (T46) by clearing 2.06m at the 12th Fazza Championships World Para Athletics Grand Prix 2021 in Dubai.

In November 2019, he secured a berth in the Tokyo Paralympics by claiming bronze at the World Para Athletics Championships at the same venue.
