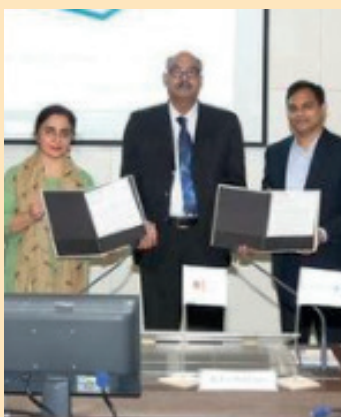

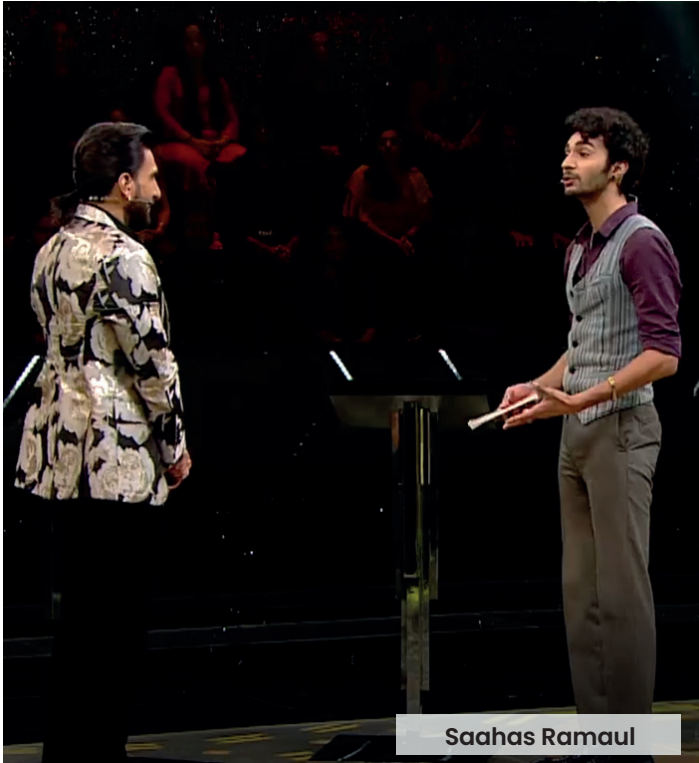
It was for the first time since Lockdown was announced in India that LPU called students from far and wide to take part in Freshmen Induction

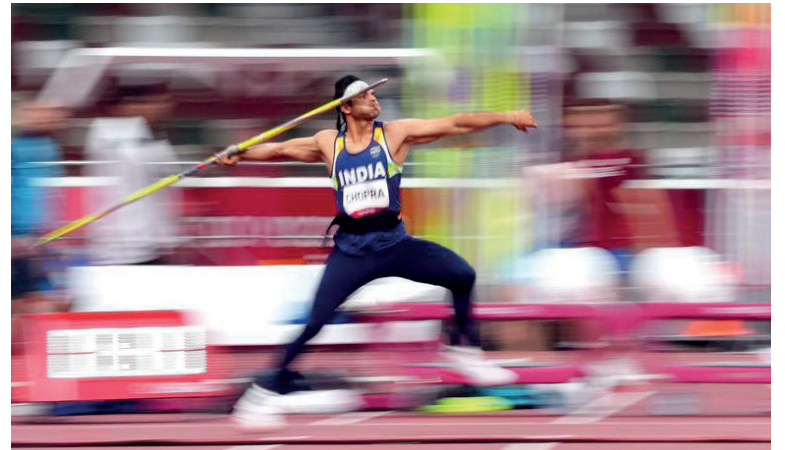
applications, mobile apps, web applications and designing due to his love for computers. He also runs a podcast show where he interacts with multiple people and learns something new every day!

20th Junior National 'Wushu' Championship at LPU Campus saw over 1500 sportsmen-women from across all States of India

LPU recently hosted the 20th Junior National 'Wushu' Championship for boys and girls at its campus. Organised by Punjab Wushu Association under the aegis of Wushu Association of India, the six-day championship saw 1500+ sportsmen-women from across all states of India.

The championship saw fights in two types of Wushu - Sanda & Taolu - and the competition was held in

nine weight categories - 45Kg, 48Kg, 52Kg, 56Kg, 60Kg, 65Kg, 70Kg, 75Kg, 80Kg for boys and five of 45 Kg, 48Kg, 52Kg, 56 Kg, 60 Kg for girls. With 26 gold, 17 silver and 12 bronze medals in both categories Manipur lifted the overall trophy of the championship.

In the Sanda form of the game Haryana won 15 gold, 5 silver and 3 bronze medals and got first position in the form; Manipur won 4 gold, 3 silver and 6 bronze at second place;

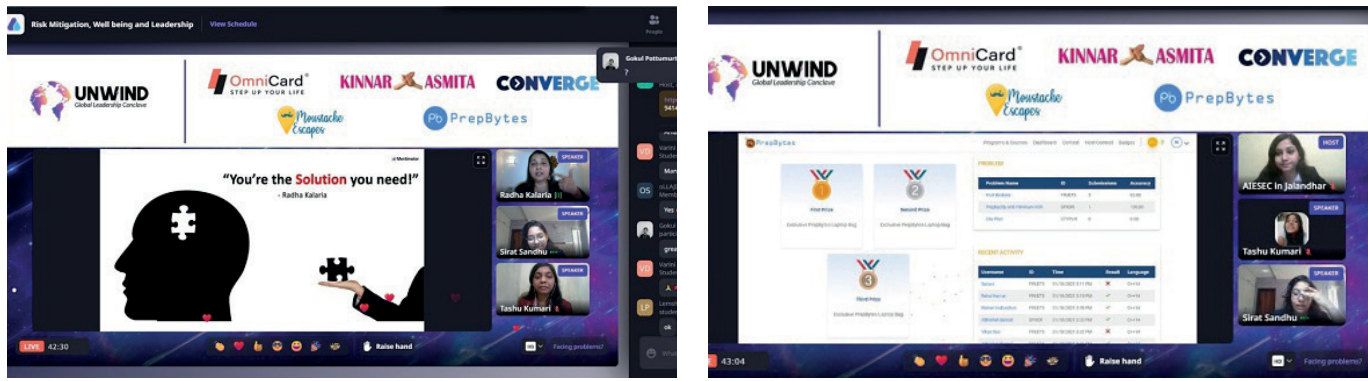

The first American woman in space, Sally Ride who flew aboard the Space Shuttle STS-7 in June of 1983. Katharine Louise Bouman is an American scientist who helped take the first ever photograph of a black hole. And Kalpana Chawla, who made history at NASA as the first female astronaut of Indian descent. Her contributions to human spaceflight have had a lasting impact.

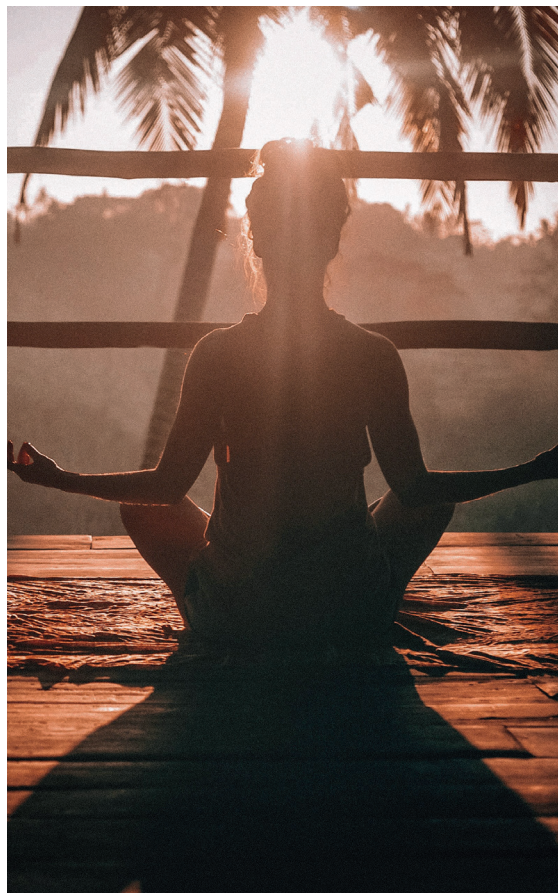

Your health is one of the most valuable things you have. Today, more than ever, people across the world are practising gratitude for health while being careful about protecting it. Pandemics and viruses aside, give your health the right priority it needs no matter what age you are. The primary purpose of your immune system is to protect against persistent bacteria that attacks your body. Your immune system acts as

Poor mental health brings psychological sufferings, one of the main reasons for these sufferings is a sense of isolation or loneliness, where one finds no support

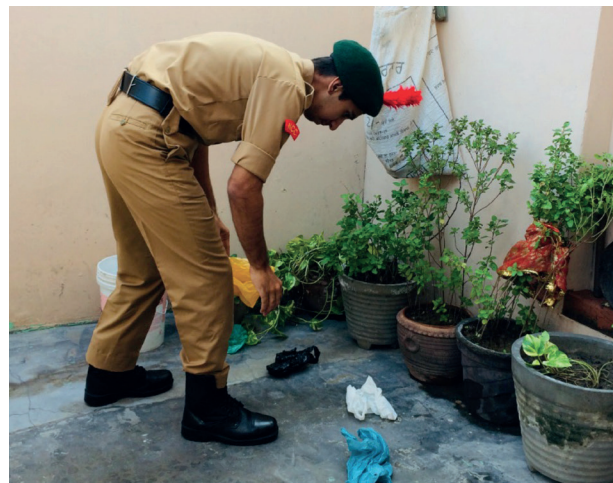
the gatekeeper for what gets in and what stays out of your body. The flu or a cold is a typical example of your body failing to stop the germs/ bacteria before they get in. Strong immunity, while crucial to prevent and fight illness, is also a key component to living a balanced, happy life.

Every part of your body functions better when it is fuelled with healthy foods, a positive environment and minimal stress. Studies say that during sleep your immune system releases proteins called cytokines. Certain cytokines need to increase when you have infection or inflammation, or when you're under stress. Sleep deprivation may decrease production of these protective cytokines.

In food components, Vitamin C and D strengthens the immune system. Vitamin C exerts its effects on host defence mechanisms and immune homeostasis. Right intake of Vitamin C is essential for life in humans because the body does not synthesize it. Studies have demonstrated that Vitamin C supplementation stimulate the immune system and significantly decrease the risk of a wide-range of pathologies. Vitamin D is also imperative for strengthening your immune system. Enjoy moderate exposure to sunlight a few times.
